We have received a request from the Company to verify the information included in Annexure A, which is proposed to be included in the red herring prospectus ("RHP") and the prospectus ("Prospectus") intended to be filed with the Registrar of Companies, West Bengal at Kolkata (the "RoC") and thereafter filed with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (the "SEBI") and any relevant stock exchange(s) where the Equity Shares are proposed to be listed (the "Stock Exchanges"), and other Offer related documents (collectively, the "Offer Documents").

We have performed the agreed upon procedures and enumerated below with respect to the operational key performance indicators including business metrics and operational data of the Company ("KPIs") as of the respective dates and for the respective period mentioned against each KPI in Annexure A (the "Periods"), set forth in the accompanying schedules. Our engagement was undertaken in accordance with the Standard on Related Services (SRS) 4400, "Engagements to Perform Agreed-upon Procedures regarding Financial Information", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, SRS 4400 is generally adopted to perform agreed upon procedures regarding financial information; however, this standard can also be used as a guide to perform agreed upon procedures regarding non-financial information.

The procedures were performed to confirm the completeness and accuracy of the KPIs of the Company and accordingly, the procedures undertaken with respect to the aforesaid are summarized below:

(i) Held discussions with the Company to (a) identify the KPIs which have been used by the management historically to analyse, track or monitor the operational and/or financial performance of the Company (b) identify the KPIs which have been disclosed to its investors at any point of time during the preceding three years and (c) understand the relevance of each of the KPIs in the business of the Company;

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- (ii) Reviewed the minutes of meetings of board and shareholders for the preceding three years to identify any KPIs shared with the investors;
- (iii) Reviewed MIS prepared by the finance department of the Company;
- (iv) Compared the amount in Annexure A for each KPI with the corresponding amounts appearing in the restated financial statements, audited standalone and consolidated financial statements, accounting records, other financial and / or operational records and registers, including invoices, management reports, internal financial and operational reports, reports used for periodic MIS reporting, management representations, reports from digital/ computerized systems, and other applicable committees and any other relevant records and documents of the Company/ subsidiaries necessary or required for verification of the relevant information, and found all such amounts to be in agreement.
- (v) In relation to the details with respect to KPIs of listed peers of the Company, compared the amount in Annexure A for each KPI of the listed peer company from the respective annual reports, results released to stock exchanges, investor presentation, prospectus of such peer companies as available publicly.
- (vi) Checked the computation, formula, arithmetic accuracy or computation of the percentages or amounts, and found all such amounts to be in agreement.

On the basis of such examination of the documents/records/information, we confirm that the information set forth in Annexures forming a part of this certificate, duly initialed by us, which is also reproduced in the Offer Documents, is correct and accurate and nothing to our attention that caused us to believe that the information contained in **Annexure A** was not accurate, valid and complete.

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## Annexure A

In evaluating its business, the Company considers and uses certain KPIs, as stated above, as a supplemental measure to review and assess its financial and operating performance. The presentation of these KPIs is not intended to be considered in isolation or as a substitute for the Restated Consolidated Financial Information. The Company uses these KPIs to evaluate its financial and operating performance. Some of these KPIs are Non-GAAP Measures. These KPIs have limitations as analytical tools. Further, these KPIs may differ from the similar information used by other companies and hence their comparability may be limited. Therefore, these metrics should not be considered in isolation or construed as an alternative to Ind AS measures of performance or as an indicator of the Company's operating performance, liquidity or results of operation. Although these KPIs are not a measure of performance calculated in accordance with applicable accounting standards, the Company's management believes that they provide an additional tool for investors to use in evaluating the Company's operating results and trends and in comparing its financial results with other companies operating in the industry because they provide consistency and comparability with past financial performance, when taken together with financial measures prepared in accordance with Ind AS.
